



Environmental Policies

House of Uniforms takes its environmental responsibilities very seriously. We strive to build a sustainable and healthy work environment for all staff and visitors.

Aside from all the standard environmental features you'd expect such as dual flush toilets, cardboard and paper recycling, energy efficient light bulbs etc, House of Uniforms is proud to have also put in place the following environmental initiatives

1. Solar Panels

Our power supply runs off a solar farm on our roof. In total we have 60 solar panels generating solar power for both our production and showroom buildings.

2. Waste Separator

As we do our screen printing on site we have a purpose built "wet room" for washing screens after jobs are completed. The plumbing in this room is fitted with a waste separator which ensures that waste chemicals and debris do not end up in the drains. The waste and debris are then pumped out periodically by a waste management company.

3. Rain Water

House of Uniforms has recently put into place all electrical and plumbing infrastructure to enable our buildings to run off a roof harvested rain water system. Our water tanks will be up and running very soon.

4. Staff Garden

House of Uniforms has a number of raised garden beds and gardens both inside and outside the office. Everyone loves the gardens and takes care of them. Inside we have a selection of indoors plants and succulents and outdoors we have a very diverse range of plants depending on the seasons. The feature of our front gardens is our bamboo and lavender.

5. Insulation

The exterior walls of our building are triple brick. All internal walls are stuffed full of high quality insulation bats. Our roof is lined with high grade insulation and sisselation. Our windows are double glazed. All these things ensure our office is as thermally efficient as possible.

6. Compost

At House of Uniforms we have thriving gardens both indoors and outdoors. The indoor plants have been specially chosen for their air purification abilities. To help our plants lead a healthy life we compost all our coffee grinds into the plant soil each week.
